In the over **4,000** community members we convened with to learn, network and collaborate to solve complex issues in our community. ECONOMIC Mobility

United Way of Greater Knoxville (UWGK) advocated to receive a **\$25 million** in a state-wide grant for our local community. With your support, we provide longterm opportunities and assistance through our East Tennessee Collaborative Program.

- 33 organizations working in financial stability received funding from UWGK
- **140** individuals were accepted into our ETC program to gain mentorship, financial assistance, and career planning
- 68 households facing homelessness were matched with affordable housing units
- 6,511 individuals were provided with basic needs assistance

2 HEALTH

UWGK is mapping the food cycle from production, processing and distribution to consumption, waste and recovery to create a more accessible and equitable food system.

- **509** organizations and **150+** individuals engaged in the creation of the food map
- 33 organizations working in health and 14 organizations working in food received funding from UWGK
- 4,000 locally-grown produce plants were distributed throughout our community
- **5,820** participants gained access to affordable mental health services

We are creating a holistic view of where resources are needed, supporting programs in health and food and empowering community members to develop innovative solutions to our community's food crisis.

B EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION

UWGK is taking action for high-quality early care and education so that all children in Knoxville-Knox County have the support they need to thrive academically, socially and in life.

- 36,149 families and caregivers gained better access to childcare resources
- 850+ community members and 40+ organizations helped us create and launch the Bright Steps Action Plan to address education needs
- Working with 25 funded agencies in education and 40 youth-serving organizations in our after school network

Our Newest Initiative:

COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

Community Schools are a way for us to connect with neighborhoods and families to ensure that they can access the resources they need no matter where a family lives in Knoxville-Knox County. Currently, we are impacting close to 6,000 children and their families through our site coordinators located at 15 public schools.
